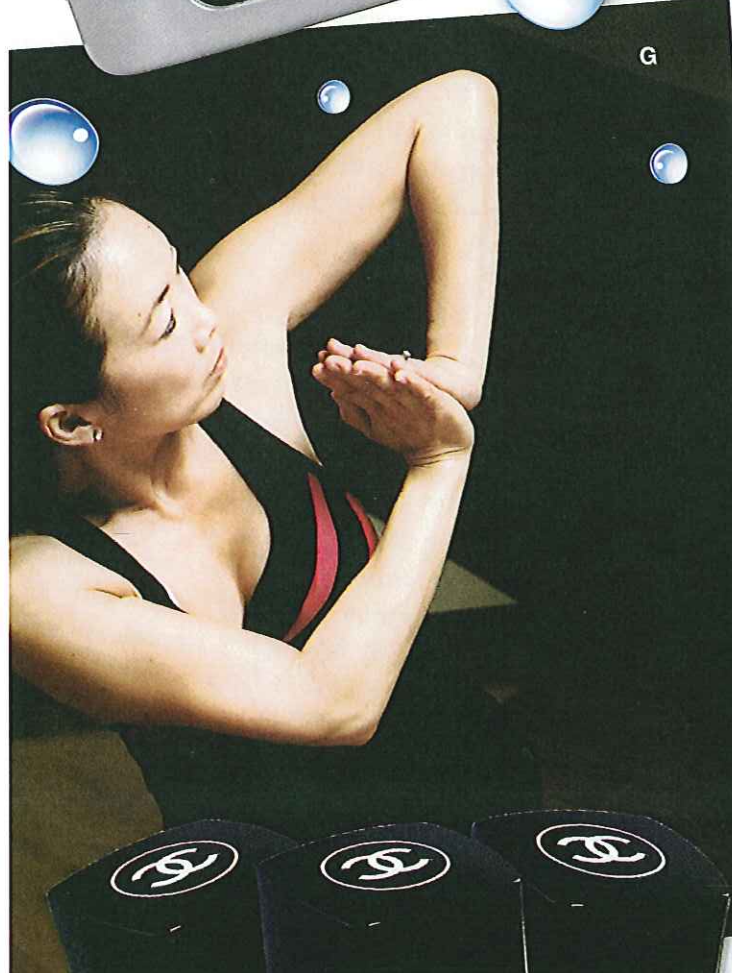

(G) This new Bikram Yoga studio is the hottest place in Kansas City, in part because the 90-minute classes take place in a room heated to 105 degrees. "The concept of the heat helps to safely stretch muscles," owner Angela Sinclair Moulin says.

Bikram is a method of hatha yoga founded by Bikram Choudhury. Consisting of 26 postures in a sequence that begins and ends with a breathing exercise, this workout builds strength and flexibility, while promoting relaxation. Classes are taught by instructors certified by Bikram himself.
